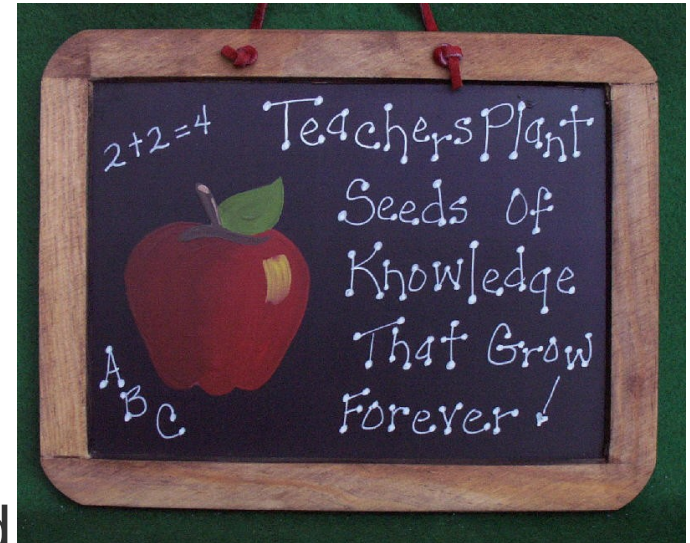
Parents and Caregivers!
